As a reminder "Caregivers are responsible for getting their children to school, which may involve getting the children to and from their nearest bus pick-up and drop-off location. Please either stay with your children while they are waiting for their school transport in the morning. It is recommended students and caregivers be at the bus pick-up/drop-off locations five to 10 minutes before the bus is scheduled to arrive. If you wish to discuss any school transport related issues, please contact Tineke."

Other regular term 1 reminders are as follows;

Sunsmart- Hats must be worn when outside, school hats are available if you forget your own. Sunscreen is also available and can be reapplied during the day as needed. We expect our students to self-manage this although we do give daily reminders.

Swimming- Bring your togs and towel every day. Weather permitting we learn to swim daily as part of our Health and PE programme. The pool is heated for the students' comfort and to prolong the swimming season.

Updated contact details- We will send home a copy of the current details we have on file for your child/ren, if any of the details have changed, address, phone numbers, emergency contacts, health status etc. please amend the form or email office@waitaria to let us know. This is an important health and safety requirement.

Attendance- From Term 1 2025, your school or kura must record student attendance data in your SMS every day you are open for instruction. This is a requirement of the Education and Training Act 2020, and the Education (School Attendance) Regulations 2024. Your SMS will submit this information to the Ministry on your behalf (from 6pm). SMS stands for Student Management System.

At Waitaria Bay School we use E-Tap as our SMS. The revised attendance codes are currently posted on the whiteboard at the front of the classroom. To help us record accurate attendance data please let us know as soon as possible if your child/ren are away and the reason.

Finally, you may have heard that Keri Drylie is relocating to Titirangi and has regretfully decided to resign her position as permanent teacher-aide. Keri has been on staff here for a number of years first as a gardener and more recently as teacher aide and staff board member. Her input over those years has been invaluable and she has developed close relationships with the students during her time. I know they will hold fond memories of their time with Keri. We are grateful to you Keri, for all that you have done over the years and your continued staunch support of Waitaria Bay School. You will be missed.

There is a Health and Safety requirement that there be two adults on site each day. I will be looking at how we can best meet this requirement, however Agi will now be in the office each Wednesday from 8.30am to 2.30pm and Ben, our caretaker will be in each Friday from 8.30am to 2.30pm.
